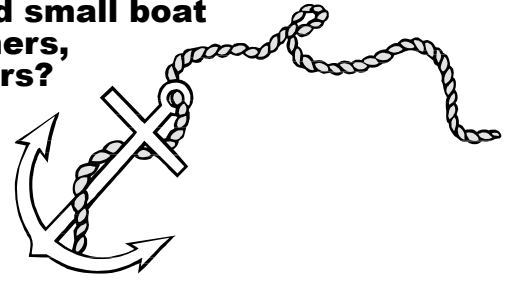


The City of Seward Small Boat Harbor is Planning and Expanding!
